



State Theater Guidelines

- Our goal is to provide you with entertainment along with keeping your safety our number one priority.
- As we navigate this new normal, we are taking every precaution to ensure your safety and we're asking our guests to do the same.
- For the time being, overall auditorium capacities are being reduced for your safety and maintain compliance with all local and state guidelines. Please allow 2 empty seats between your group and the next closest guest.
- You may wear a mask at your discretion.
- Please practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from fellow guests and volunteers in all areas of the movie theater including entrances, lobbies, concession areas, restrooms, hallways and the auditorium.
- In areas of the theater where proper social distancing between volunteers and guests isn't otherwise possible such as concession registers and interior ticket booths, plexiglass barrier screens will be used for added security.
- Any guest who feels unwell, has a fever, and/or has any COVID-19 like symptoms is asked to please refrain from entering the movie theater and a refund can be provided if necessary.
- We encourage you to purchase tickets in advance on the State Theater Foundation app or website (www.statetheaterfoundation.org).
- The auditorium will be sanitized every night after the movie. Common areas and high touch points will be routinely disinfected.
- All volunteers are provided with facial masks and gloves to wear during their shifts. Frequent handwashing and changing of gloves are required.
- For your convenience, hand sanitizers are available at the concession areas and ticket booth.
- Items like napkins, straws and condiments will be available upon request.
