



## State Theater Guidelines

- Our goal is to provide you with entertainment along with keeping your safety our number one priority.
- As we navigate this new normal, we are taking every precaution to ensure your safety & we're asking our guests to do the same.
- For the time being, overall auditorium capacities are being reduced for your safety & maintain compliance with all local & state guidelines. Please allow 2 empty seats between your group & the next closest guest.
- We encourage face masks be worn throughout the theater but may be removed when eating & drinking inside the auditorium.
- Please practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from fellow guests & volunteers in all areas of the movie theater including entrances, lobbies, concession areas, restrooms, hallways & auditorium.
- In areas of the theater where proper social distancing between volunteers & guests isn't otherwise possible such as concession registers & interior ticket booths, plexiglass barrier screens will be used for added security.
- Any guest who feels unwell, has a fever, and/or has any COVID-19 like symptoms is asked to please refrain from entering the movie theater & a refund can be provided if necessary.
- We encourage you to purchase tickets in advance on the State Theater Foundation app or website ([www.statetheaterfoundation.org](http://www.statetheaterfoundation.org)).
- The auditorium will be sanitized every night after the movie. Common areas & high touch points will be routinely disinfected.
- All volunteers are provided with face masks to wear during their shifts. Frequent handwashing will be required.
- For your convenience, hand sanitizers are available at the concession areas & ticket booth.
- Items like napkins, straws & condiments will be available upon request.
